

Secret Service Extension Act of 2024

AN ACT

To extend Secret Service protection for past Presidents and Vice Presidents indefinitely.

INTRODUCED BY

Senator GDKfonzo for the great state of Illinois introduced this bill on 25 July 2024.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled—

TITLE I – GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 101. Short Title.

- (a) This Act shall be referred to as the ‘Secret Service Extension Act of 2024’ or ‘SSEA’ as its short title.

Section 102. Enforcement and Severability.

- (a) This Act remains ‘severable’ in accordance with the severability doctrine maintained and developed by the courts of the United States.
- (b) This Act shall come into effect immediately upon proper constitutionally recognized promulgation.

TITLE II – PROTECTION DETAILS

Section 201. Past Presidents and Vice Presidents eligibility.

- (a) Past Presidents and Vice Presidents must be present in the nUSA Presidential Archives and be a current citizen of nUSA to be eligible for protection.
- (b) Past Presidents and Vice Presidents may not request protection if they are declared Arrest on Site.

Section 202. Protection Terms.

- (a) Protectees will only receive protection when requested in the Secret Service Discord server.
- (b) Protectees who fail to cooperate with Secret Service protection policies may be denied from receiving protection.
- (c) Protectees may not request protection at the same time as high priority protectees but are permitted to join their detail if granted permission by the high priority protectee.
